- All Summer 2017 housing fees will be charged to student fee bills after you arrive on campus.
- Students will be billed for the dates they register for. Students who leave early, or arrive late will not be refunded for the dates they were not here. If a student stays longer than the dates registered for, they will be charged for additional dates.

Change in Billing Policy 2017 and 2018

Residential Life will not be adjusting fee bills when a housing reservation is changed to a shorter time frame. This applies **after** the fee bill charges have been generated, which usually occurs after you check in. The billing amount will remain the same on the fee bill even if you check out earlier than the end of your reservation. However, if you stay beyond your reservation end date, you will be charged for the extra night(s).

Also, for summer 2018, housing will be charging a weekly housing rate rather than a nightly rate for the Three Summers group.

Note: Garrigus Suites Community Center is walking distance to Hilltop Apartments. Because parking on Alumni Drive is limited, I suggest you park at Hilltop Apartments and walk to Garrigus.
