

THREE SUMMERS 2017 FINANCIAL AID

Financial Aid

Questions regarding the financial aid application process or eligibility requirements should be directed to the Office of Student Financial Aid Services (OSFAS) <http://financialaid.uconn.edu/> or 860-486-2819. There is often a large volume of telephone calls, be prepared to wait in a queue for several minutes, but do not hang up, your call will be answered in the order in which it is received. You may also email them at financialaid@uconn.edu – include your 7-digit UConn student ID # and also identify yourself as a Three Summers in Education graduate student.

If you plan to take summer courses at UConn during the 2017 summer session (this includes EPSY 5195 or 5198 Confratute for credit) and wish to be considered for financial aid, the following items are required:

- A valid 2016-2017 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) (<http://fafsa.ed.gov>) – to be considered for Federal Pell Grant, Federal PLUS Loan, or any remaining Federal Stafford Loan eligibility. (Please note, to be considered for remaining Federal Student Loan eligibility, student's must be enrolled for a minimum of 6 credits.)
- A summer financial aid application (available via the Student Administration System on Tuesday March 21, 2017) – to be considered for remaining Federal Pell Grant, Federal PLUS Loan, or any remaining Federal Stafford Loan eligibility.
- A completed online application (available via studentloans.gov) – if applying for a [Federal Direct Parent PLUS or Graduate PLUS Loan](#).
- A Private (Alternative) Loan application submitted directly to the lender of your choice – if applying for a [Private \(Alternative\) Loan](#).

The Summer 2017 financial aid awarding process will begin in April 2017. Students must be in compliance with the University of Connecticut's [Satisfactory Academic Progress Policy](#) to be eligible for Federal financial aid for the summer. Satisfactory Academic Progress will be evaluated in May, 2017.

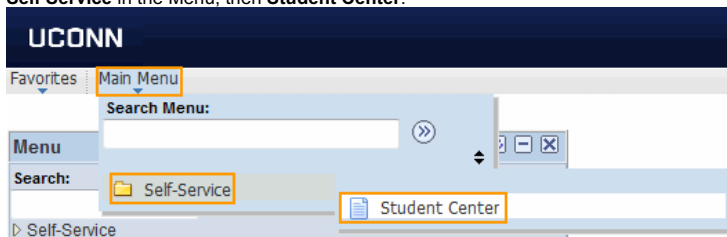
The last day to accept Federal loans for summer is **Wednesday August 23, 2017**.

View Financial Aid

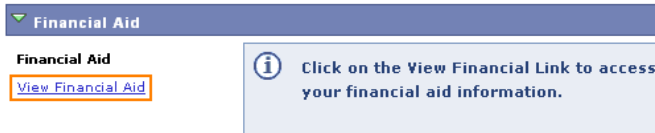
