
THREE SUMMERS 2019 PARKING DRIVING DIRECTIONS TRANSPORTATION

Parking

Summer 2019 parking permits are free of charge. Below are two options to register. Registration deadline June 13, 2019.

- Complete and submit the online parking application <u>https://web2.uconn.edu/parking/studentparking2/index.php</u>, then email registration confirmation to judith.mathews@uconn.edu, who will arrange to pick up permits before your arrival*.
- Download, print, complete, and sign the parking application, <u>https://gifted.education.uconn.edu/wp-content/uploads/sites/612/2019/04/Student Parking Application-Summer 2019.pdf</u>, then e-mail to <u>judith.mathews@uconn.edu</u>, who will arrange to pick up permits before your arrival*. The campus affiliation and special permit option boxes are selected for you.

*Permits will be in welcome packets if you register on or before the June 13 deadline.



From the West – Interstate 84 East to Exit 68. From exit, take a right onto Route 195, and follow for 7 miles to campus.

Alternate directions from the West – Interstate 84 East to Interstate 384 East. At end of Interstate 384 East, take left fork to Route 44 East. Follow Route 44 East to intersection with Route 195. Take a right onto Route 195 and follow the signs to campus.

From the East - Interstate 84 West to Exit 68. From exit, take a left onto Route 195, and follow for 7 miles to campus.

From the Southeast – Interstate 95 to 395 North. Take Exit 81 West to Route 32 North. Follow Route 32 North to Willimantic. In town, turn right and go over bridge. Continue straight through the light and follow 195 North for 8 miles to campus.

Transportation

The Bradley International Airport (<u>https://bradleyairport.com</u>) services Hartford, CT and is located about 45 minutes from campus. Ground transportation must be arranged for travel to the university.

Peter Pan (Bonanza) Bus Lines have regularly scheduled stops to UConn. Schedules and ticketing information are available at https://peterpanbus.com/.
